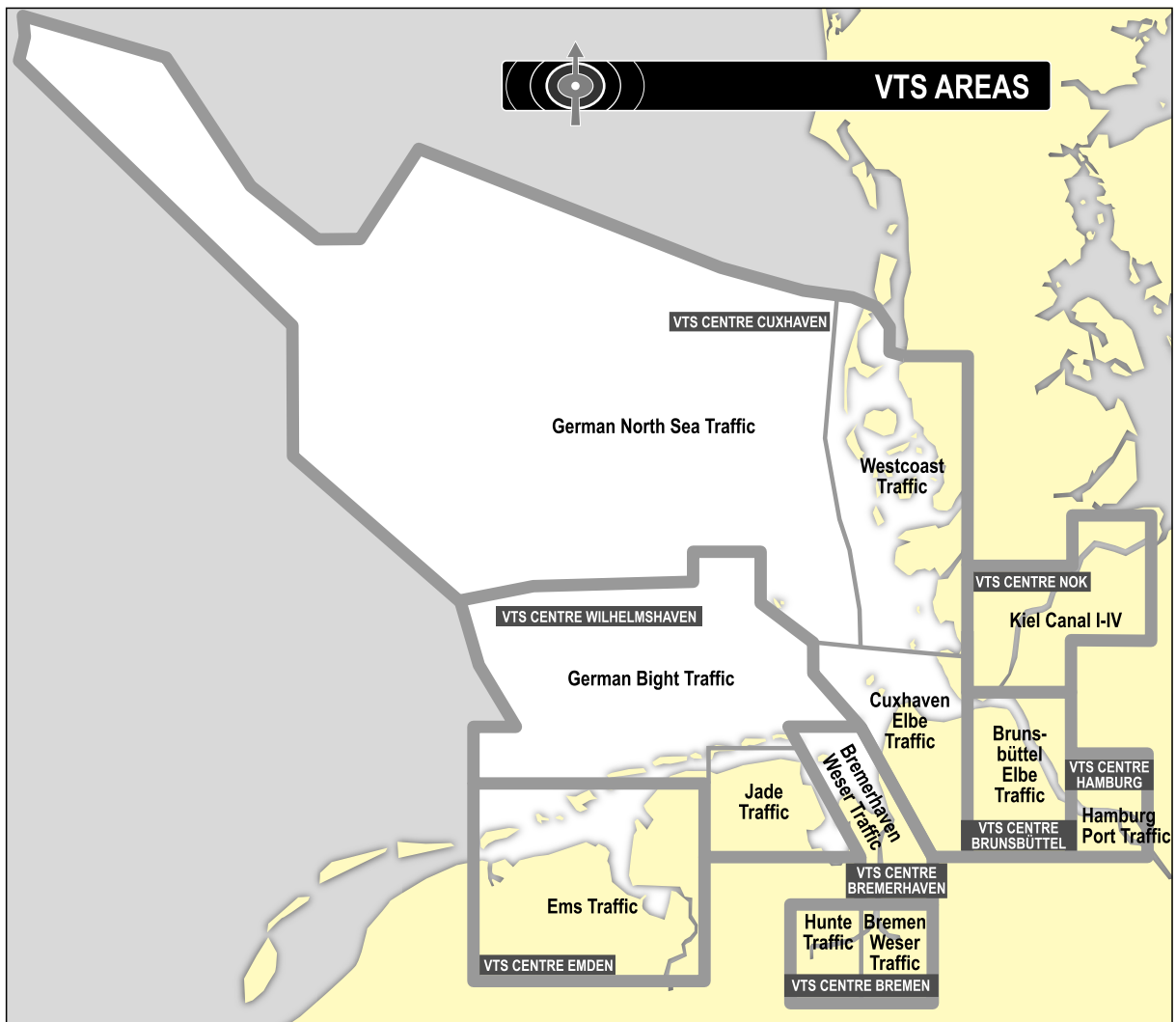
Preface / Explanatory notes
